Jain Education and Research Foundation

Under the spiritual guidance of Late Acharya Mahapragya, with blessings from Acharya Mahashraman and through the efforts of Samani Charitra Prajna (Vice Chancellor, Jain Vishwa Bharati University) and Dr. Dipak Jain (renowned educationist and management expert, ex-Dean, Kellogg School of Business, Northwestern University) foundation established a historic milestone when it endowed a perpetual professorship in Jain Studies at FIU in 2010. This was the first ever endowed professorship on Jain studies anywhere outside of India. The efforts of JERF have received acclaim all around including special blessings from HH Dalai Lama. This is unique, first ever initiative in western world by the Jain community and will hopefully pave the way for many more to come in near future.

Curriculum

Jainism related courses offered at FIU

REL 3020: Meditation and Spiritual Development

Explores the ancient tradition of Jainism with comparative meditation, its history & practice.

REL 3024: Religion, Life and Vegetarianism

Explores the concepts of food, family and vegetarian habits in relation to eastern religions.

REL 3310: Introduction to Asian religions

Analyzes the basic concepts of Jainism in context
of other Asian Religions.

REL 3330: Religions of India

Explores the core religions born in India--the spiritual heritage which India cherishes.

REL 4311: Religious Classics of Asia REL 6935: Seminar on Sacred Texts

Courses give an exposure to the core Classics of the religion. Students read the original sacred texts (like Acharang...) to learn the philosophy, understand the culture, and revere the richness.

BHAGAWAN MAHAVIR PROFESSORSHIP OF JAIN STUDIES

Jain Education & Research Foundation established a \$1 million endowment at Florida International University for the Bhagawan Mahavir Professorship of Jain Studies, the first professorship of its kind in the western world. The endowment is part of a larger initiative by the Jain community to establish an academic education center for Jain studies. The proposed Bhagawan Mahavir Interdisciplinary Center for Religious Pluralism would offer Jainism courses, provide research opportunities and collaborate with universities worldwide.

ANNUAL LECTURE SERIES

FIU's Religious Studies department and Jain community invites orators, academicians and nonviolence activists under its Annual Nonviolence lecture series to awaken consciousness of people.

STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The student exchange program allows an FIU student to visit Jain Vishwa Bharati University in Ladnun, Rajasthan for three weeks for studies and vice versa. The Jain Fellowship covers airfare + \$500 tuition fee. In a short period of three weeks, students receive 3 credits, while exploring Jainism, Non-violence and Meditation. The JVBU also offers an opportunity to visit local sites & villages.
