The summary of the camp is:

- In his book Understanding Joy and Sorrow Acharya Mahapragyaji links the sensation of Joy and Sorrow to rays of consciousness that are flowing from within and cannot be created. The cycle of joy and sorrow is perennial. Favorable conditions stimulate joy, whereas unfavorable conditions result in sorrow. Human mind plays an important role in these emotions. The same mind that makes human beings the smartest creatures in the world also causes it sorrow. The inability of a mind to differentiate between the body and soul causes sorrow. Another way of putting it is to say that Joy and Sorrow are/ transitory states of mind, whereas Happiness is beyond Joy and Sorrow – in fact a state beyond the mind.
- In this camp we will understand how to achieve such a state by practicing meditation.
